*"Bordeaux style" is typically used to refer to a new world wine that uses the same combination of grapes as in the actual Bordeaux region of France, red wines are blended from **Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc** and sometime the addition of **Malbec** and **Petite Verdot**. In the new world these blends are often referred to as 'Meritage' wines, a clever derivative of the words merit' and 'heritage' referring both to the quality of the grapes and the age old tradition of blending Bordelaise varieties.*
